

Breaking Apart Ones for Addition

$$26 + 5 = ?$$

Digit in ones place of two digit addend = 6

You need 4 to make the ones digit 10.

$$6 + 4 = 10 \text{ and } 26 + 4 = 30$$

Now, subtract 4 from one digit addend.

$$5 - 4 = 1$$

So, "30 + 1 = 31" is the answer.
