



Simple Word Problem on Mental Subtraction

Solve the word problem on mental subtractions:

1. Timmy had 15 marbles, but he lost 8 of them while playing in the garden. How many marbles does Timmy have left?
2. There were 18 students in a class. 7 students went on a field trip. How many students are left in the class?
3. A farmer had 50 eggs. He sold 20 of them at the market. How many eggs does the farmer have left?
4. There were 40 seats in a movie theater. If 28 seats were occupied, how many seats are empty?
5. Jack had 35 toy cars. He gave away 18 toy cars to his friends. How many toy cars does Jack have now?
6. There were 30 candies in a jar. 15 candies were eaten by the children. How many candies are still in the jar?
