1. Mary had 22 stickers, but she decided to give away 6 of them to her brother. How many stickers does Mary have left?
2. There were 25 balloons at the party, but 7 of them popped. How many balloons are still inflated at the party?
3. Amy had 16 dollars in her piggy bank, but she spent 5 dollars on a toy. How much money does Amy have left in her piggy bank?
4. There were 35 books on the shelf, but 10 of them were borrowed by friends. How many books are still on the shelf?
5. Tom had 50 trading cards, but he lost 14 of them. How many trading cards does Tom have now?
6. Mary had 22 stickers, but she decided to give away 6 of them to her brother. How many stickers does Mary have left?
